EVMB UNIFORM ETIQUETTE:

- Member t-shirts are the only acceptable thing to wear underneath your jacket.
- Wear lightweight athletic shorts or spandex shorts underneath your pants.
- Long black socks (no markings) are the only acceptable thing to wear on your feet.
- BIBBERS (pants) must be always up over your shoulders, not resting at waist.
- NEVER DRINK anything other than water and NEVER EAT any food in uniform, unless specifically given permission by the director or another staff member.
- Do not rest on, sit on, or lean on anything that could potentially damage your uniform or get it dirty (i.e. the ground, fences, railings, etc.).
- If your JACKET is off it must be folded properly and set on top of/inside your hat neatly. Do not set it directly on the ground.
- HATS are either properly on or in your hands. When placed on the ground they are placed upright.
- No visible JEWELRY while in uniform (watches, rings are discouraged).
- Everybody's HAIR must be entirely up under their hat and band members should not wear make-up.
- The uniform represents all of the TRADITIONS and HISTORY of the Eastview Marching Band. Please treat the uniforms and yourselves with respect.
